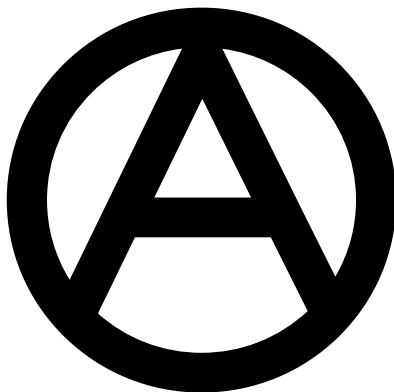

# Welcome to Pinksterlanddagen!

This year we celebrate the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Pinksterlanddagen. The first one was held back in 1924, in Appelscha. Since the year 1933, and this year too, the Pinksterlanddagen take place at campsite ‘Tot Vrijheidsbeinning’!



## WHAT IS PINKSTERLANDDAGEN (PL)?

PL is a yearly anarchist festival that takes place at the anarchist campsite ‘Tot Vrijheidsbeinning’ during the weekend of Pentecost (translation: Pinksteren). It’s an event for anarchists and everyone who’s inspired by, or interested in anarchism.

PL is a festival that was organized for the first time in 1924 under the name of Pinkstermobilisatie. That means it’s now 98 years ago that Pinksterlanddagen was organized for the first time!

For many anarchists this festival is a place to get together. In this booklet you’ll find more info about the campsite.

The weekend is full of workshops, readings and discussions about anarchism. There’s also a program for kids and in the evenings there’s a cultural program with some awesome bands and

performances. In times of increasing economic inequality, growing fascism, climate chaos, individualization and (state) surveillance it’s more important than ever to get together and share experiences, have discussions, get to know each other and learn from each other.

- You can also camp on the terrain when there is no PL. Next to camping there is also a cottage that you can rent for up until 7 persons. Also suitable for elderly people and people with disabilities.

## **ENTRANCE**

Similar to previous years the entrance fee will be donation-based. We want to make the festival as accessible as possible for those who have less disposable income. If you can afford it, we ask that you donate the suggested amount, or even a little bit more, to compensate for those who can't afford the suggested amount. The suggested donation for 1 day is €10 and for the whole weekend €17,50.

## **FOOD**

Dinner and lunch will be cooked by **Rampenplan**, a cooking collective that has been active for many years. The roots of Rampenplan are in the early eighties: arising from large action kitchens at, for example, blockades of nuclear power plants. From those actions a collectively organised mobile vegetarian kitchen developed, cooking throughout Europe at a range of different events, from demonstrations to cycle/hiking tours, conferences and much more. They serve biological and vegetarian/vegan food.

Rampenplan can always use a helping hand, so if you're interested in helping out, please do come over to the kitchen and sign up.

You can get food coupons at the entrance caravan of the festival. Preferably get them early on, so Rampenplan knows for how many people they're cooking on that day.

## **THE CANTEEN**

The canteen is a place where you can sit down with a nice juice, a tasty sandwich and sometimes there is even a cake! Ofcourse there is tea and coffee. The food in the canteen is biological: we want to take care of our fellow humans as well as nature and biological food & cleaning supplies are part of that.

We buy the food at a wholesale store, this is how we keep the cost low. This way we can provide food against a decent price. If you'd like to get something else: there's two regular supermarkets in the village center of Appelscha. This year everything in the canteen has two prices, for example: €1,- / €2,-. The lower price is for when you have a low income and can't afford to pay more. The second price is the regular price.

In the canteen there's also a schedule for cleaning and chores. You can list your own name there. The overview also tells you where to find cleaning supplies so you can get cleaning! If you'd like to help in the canteen, i.e. with making sandwiches, doing dishes, making coffee & tea or help our behind the bar: there is also a schedule for this! The whole weekend is based on people who volunteer. The more people help out, the smoother the weekend will run!

## **TRASH**

We try to separate trash as well as possible. You can see this at the entrance of the terrain, across the entrance caravan. Try to separate your trash in the correct bins, and if possible: take out your own trash from the terrain. This way we help the campsite so they don't have to pay too much for garbage disposal.

Also clean up after yourselves in the forest. Pick up your cans and bottles. You can return them to the supermarket in the village.

# Some Practical issues:

- The campsite and therefore also the Pinksterlanddagen are free of alcohol and drugs.
- All toilets are gender neutral.
- There is a wheelchair accessible toilet and shower in the bungalow house. If you have any questions about this, please come to the entrance caravan.
- If you have any allergies or relevant questions about the food, please come by the kitchen well in advance. They can usually help you out and make you a separate plate.
- There is no ATM at the campsite, so make sure you bring enough cash. The nearest ATM is in the center of the village Appelscha.
- Make sure you get your food coupons in time at the entrance caravan. This is so Rampenplan knows how many people they're cooking for.
- Did something happen, are you feeling unwell or did you have an accident? There are a few people who can provide first aid during the festival. These people are available through the entrance caravan.
- Organizing Pinksterlanddagen is a lot of work and during the festival we can always use some help. The revolution starts with doing dishes, cleaning toilets, building up stands and cleaning up on Monday! Please do try to help out! There's an overview of all the chores for the weekend in the canteen, you can write your name in this schedule!
- Outside, at the canteen, there's a big blackboard with the latest updates about possible changes in the program. You can also ask questions through the blackboard about i.e. carpool and drop off requests.
- On and surrounding the campsite are a lot of ticks. Ticks may cause Lyme disease. In case of a bite from a tick remove the tick as quickly as possible using a tick remover? If red circles appear around the bite go see your general practitioner.
- If you need anything urgently during PL (you need first aid, a tent is flying away, the bouncy castle is malfunctioning, you feel unsafe or something else): call 0684106526.
- Take care to bring all your tent pegs back home. Leaving them in the meadow is unsafe for the cows.

# No place for repression

The campsite and the Pinksterlanddagen are anarchist space. We live in a capitalist, racist, militarist and patriarchal system where large groups of people are oppressed, taken advantage of, marginalized and excluded. We strive to create a space where these repressive power structures are not repeated: we want everyone to feel at home during Pinksterlanddagen. This means there is no place for sexism, racism, ableism, xenophobia, islamophobia, homophobia, transphobia, classism or any other discrimination: in both behaviour as well as language. Of course we can't do this without your help, so we ask everyone to actively be aware of their own privileges and to consider in how far the position of others may be different from your own position.

Be aware of differences, other people's boundaries, listen to each other, appreciate when others point something out. Only then it will be possible to treat each other with mutual respect. Being aware of each other's boundaries and your own privileges and treating them with understanding is something that can be learned.

Point this out to each other and consider it as a chance to improve yourself when something is pointed out to you. Keep an open mind and keep space for an open conversation. Listen to how our own behaviour has an influence on other people and take responsibility for it.

Try not to make assumptions about others, for example about where they come from or about what pronouns they use (she/they/he/...). By pointing out things to each other we can learn something and improve. This way we can create mutual understanding and a nice and safer vibe.

Having said this, we want to acknowledge that we don't live in the illusion that this will automatically be a safer space for everyone.

It might happen that you'll be approached this year by someone who feels unsafe or uncomfortable if you'll attend Pinksterlanddagen or specific workshops. Please respect this and give the other person space. Sometimes it's good to take a step back and reflect.

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Lastly there's a term in the program we'd like to explain: FLINTA. This is an acronym for: female, lesbian, intersex, non-binary, trans, asexual/aromantic. A FLINTA group is a group that chooses to only work together with others who's identities are FLINTA.

# Some history about the colorful developments of the campsite

## **ANARCHIST STRONGHOLD**

This campsite has a very rich history. Appelscha used to be a stronghold of the 'free socialists' (a Dutch political movement and forerunner of the modern Anarchist movement). The first 'Revolutionary Anti-Militarist Land Day' was organized in 1924 in the forest close to Appelscha. In 1933 – running up to the second world war – the Land Days were prohibited. That was the reason for three anarchists from the north to start looking for their own piece of land. In the same year, quietly, they bought a potato field for 500 guilders to ensure the continuation of the yearly Pinksterlanddagen. From 1934 onwards the Pinksterlanddagen was organized on this former potato field.

The potato field has transformed into the campsite it is right now thanks to the work of the permanent campers and guests. A simple campsite with water, electricity, bathroom & shower stalls. Later the building with the canteen was built and more recently the bungalow house was built.

## **CAMPSITE**

The terrain has approximately 30 static caravan spaces and is kept up and managed by the group of people using these permanent caravan spots. This group consists of individuals, couples, families and collectives. Besides the permanent places there is also room to camp out with a tent or campervan. There is a bungalow house that can be rented; it is also suitable for elderly or people with disabilities.

The canteen with the large (stage) room and kitchen can be rented out to groups and collectives. In the canteen there is also an extensive historical archive of Anarchist material. For kids there's a small playground, as well as a huge forest to build huts and explore.

The campsite lies on the border of the Drents-Friese Wold – a unique nature area with forests, dunes and moorlands, where a wolf even visited last year. It's also close to Fochteloërveen, a unique piece of swamp and moorland with very special flora and fauna. At night you can enjoy the clear sky and stars and maybe even glimpse an owl flying over the moorland... During summertime the Aekinga Lake is within cycling distance, where you can rest and enjoy the natural surroundings.

## **DOWNFALL AND CONSERVATION**

During the purchase of the terrain in 1933 the collective's lawyer advised starting a foundation to own the terrain collectively. It was also decided that the board of the foundation would not have the final say in decision making, but the final say would be for the meeting of permanent campers. Starting an association would be too risky, because different anarchist groups didn't always agree with each other and there was quite some infighting. The campsite couldn't be allowed to fail because of that. Ironically, the legal advice didn't protect the campsite from an imminent downfall.

Despite the agreement that the final decision would be with the meeting of permanent



campers, the board of the foundation didn't care much about the meeting. The board of the foundation made decisions without involving the permanent campers or ignored decisions made in the meeting of permanent campers. The campers and the organizers of Pinksterlanddagen resisted against this authoritarian behaviour more and more, because the methods of the board of the foundation didn't fit an anarchist campsite.

External mediation, a rent strike: nothing seemed to work. The conflict got very heated and the permanent campers wanted to get rid of the board of the foundation (and vice versa).

In late 2018, the foundation all of a sudden decided to sell the terrain. The permanent campers were given the choice: either they would have to buy the terrain or the terrain would be sold on the free market. The latter

could mean that after 86 years the only anarchist campsite in the Netherlands would come to an end. Luckily the permanent campers managed to buy the terrain, thanks to a lot of support from the anarchist movement!

### **THE FUTURE IS OURS!**

As permanent campers we are now organized in our own foundation. We're currently discussing what form would be fitting for our anarchist campsite, a form in which everyone can contribute and in which the decision making will always be done by the permanent campers. We want to get started with this and spend our energy on maintenance and improving the campsite. Now the conflict is in the past, we can start building. So many ideas: making the buildings more sustainable, generating our own energy, organizing the campsite, facilitating more political events, promoting the campsite more... We're ready!

# Workshops and lectures

## **BOOKPRESENTATION GRAPHIC NOVEL 'UITWEG' AND TALK WITH ABORTION NETWORK AMSTERDAM**

B.Carrot presents het new graphic novel. Central themes in this book are the right to self-determination, reproductive justice and radical empathy. Together with activist from Abortion Netwerk Amsterdam (ANA) they will talk about pro-abortion activism, the state of affairs concerning abortion law the cooperation with B.Carrot and the making of 'Uitweg'.

## **URGENCY OF ANTI-MILITARISM**

The Pinksterlanddagen will take place at the 'Vrij-socialistische, antimilitaristische, drugs- en alcoholvrije terrein tot Vrijheidsbevinning' (Free Socialist, Antimilitarist, Drug and Alcohol Free camping grounds for freedom reflection). Antimilitarism has played an

important role in the history of the anarchist movement as a battleground against oppression, state power and international power politics. In recent years, it is a subject that is not addressed as much anymore. At the same time, rapid militarization is taking place in the Netherlands and Europe. The fear of Russians and Chinese is being rammed in and military budgets continue to rise. The arms industry receives financial support from all sides and ample room to export more. Dutch weapons, as in Gaza, will increasingly contribute to war and repression. More than ever, weapons and armies are being used to suppress problems by force; from migration to climate crisis. The protectors of peace and security protect the rich, at the expense of the poorest, the most vulnerable, and ultimately the entire planet.

In this workshop we will talk about the topicality and urgency of antimilitarism in today's struggles through a series of statements. Why is antimilitarism an important topic, also for people and groups engaged in e.g. climate, migration, decolonial struggles? We will look,

using videos of actions from home and abroad, at how antimilitarism takes shape and what we can do, here and now, to take action.

## **THE PALESTINIAN BDS MOVEMENT: A CRITICAL APPRAISAL**

A lecture on the Palestinian Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions movement, better known as BDS - its history and context, impact and achievements, theoretical grounding and significance, and some criticisms.

Nadim holds a master's degree in Middle Eastern Studies from the American University of Beirut. He has been an organizer and involved in various movements for many years, including the global climate movement, the Occupy Wall Street movement, and the 2019 Lebanese uprising. He is currently based in Copenhagen and a member of the International Forum.

## **DIRECT ACTION TRAINING BY PALESTINE ACTION AMSTERDAM**

You went to some sit-ins, but now you want to get off your ass and do something bigger! At the direct action training you'll learn what tools and strategies you can use for Palestine Action, what your legal risks are and how to keep yourself and others safe. Best case scenario: yo'll be able to find comrades to start your own Pal Action group with.

We can also answer (most) questions on Palestine Action Netherlands, grounds on which we base our direct action and how to dismantle Dutch complicity in Israeli apartheid and the ongoing genocide in Gaza and of Palestinian people.

## **STRIVING TOWARDS TRANS SELF DETERMINATION UNDER INCREASED HOSTILITY**

With the rise of transphobia in politics, media, and everyday life, pro-trans activism is being made more and more difficult. Self determination in trans healthcare is seemingly a more distant goal than before, and yet the waiting lists are longer than they've ever been.

But the battle isn't over, and we will not give up! The previous strategy Trans Zorg Nu (TZN) used is no longer viable, which is why we held a strategy day where we invited a couple of collectives to discuss and reinvent our strategy with us. In a couple of weeks we will hold a community day with the goal of allowing personal networks of trans-activists to grow, and to introduce non-activists to trans-activism.

In this workshop we will share what our old strategy used to be, how and why we changed it. And our plans for the community day.

## **SUPPORTING ANARCHIST PRISONERS IN BELARUS: CHALLENGES AND RISK RELATED TO SOLIDARITY WORK**

Anarchist Black Cross Belarus turns 15 years this year. Since 2010, there have never been a time when we didn't not have at least one anarchist or antifascist prisoner in Belarus. Now we support 30 on a regular basis.

In this presentation, we will share the information on the current state of the anarchist movement in Belarus and in exile and some details about operating as a solidarity group in the context when your own movement virtually stops existing and your support can mean more prison terms and harassment for those who receive our help.

## COMPASSION FOR ACTIVISTS

Activism and criticism go hand in hand. Without criticism there is no activism and activists are good at voicing their criticism of wrongs in order to achieve a better and free world for all.

However, there is also a toxic form of criticism that can lead to fatigue, burnout, negativism and destruction. The idea that you always fall short or that you can do better is often heard within activist circles. Self-reflection and self-criticism are certainly good tools for making actions more efficient and effective. But how do you do that in a compassionate way, because often the intentions are good, but the results do not always turn out the way you thought they would.

The workshop deals with how to deal with criticism towards yourself and other in a more compassionate way, in order to create more understanding, space and freedom for yourself and others to develop.

## WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE ARRESTED

The arrestee support group is hosting a workshop on preparing for arrest, interrogation, and your rights when arrested. Talk along from your own experience, ask questions about the ghost stories you've heard, and learn what to look out for. The workshop will cover topics including:

1. What an arrestee group is and what the group does like
2. What your rights and obligations are if you are arrested
3. Interrogation training
4. The usefulness and necessity of not declaring
5. How an arrest and cell detention actually works
6. How to best prepare for an action
7. The importance of Security Culture and Support & Recovery, among others, and of course more!

## WILDCRAFTING

Why go to the store to buy tea, when on your way there you have already come across many plants you can throw into your hot water?

Often they are beneficial too, didn't cost chemicals to get there and don't contribute to the exploitation of the world (as long as you pick from the wild pickers code).

In this workshop we'll look for edible plants in the forest, I'll give tools for identification, we'll talk about the wild pickers code, we'll discuss reciprocity, you'll learn about some of the risks, and we'll actually make a wild pick tea. By beginning to wildpick and study nature, you will take, where possible

regain control of your diet, health and have a positive impact on nature and your environment. You save money, get exercise and vit D, and it's also good for your digestive system/your health. And also important, you become even more autonomous.

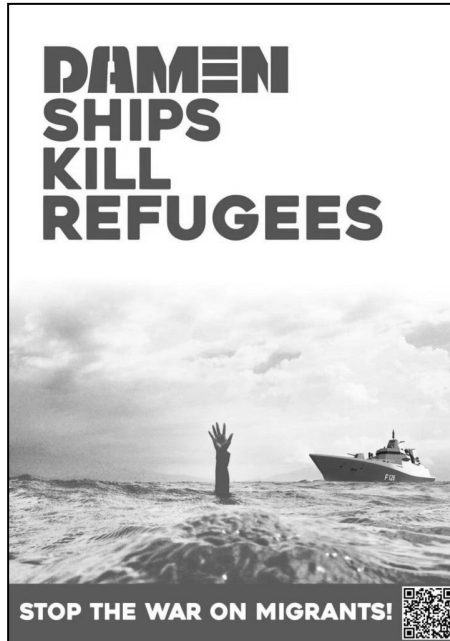

## **MAPPING CONNECTIONS OF THE MILITARY AND BORDER INDUSTRIAL COMPLEX AND BEYOND**

Interactive workshop about mapping out activities and partnerships of companies and institutions - using the example of arms company Damen - as a base for strategic and tactical discussions on how to target them.

The military- and border-industrial complex is present all throughout our society. How can we untangle this complex system and take action against it? In campaigns and actions against companies a good understanding and overview of their activities, presence and relations is vital to develop good strategies and make tactical decisions about how we can best use our time, energy and resources. A lot of the surroundings, including shareholders, research partners, customers/clients and sponsor relations, can be good points of intervention to target a particular company.

In this interactive workshop, we will map out the activities and partnerships of one of the most important Dutch arms companies, shipbuilder Damen, a large player in the international border security market. Together we will see how companies that produce violence and oppression elsewhere are present here, and think about how to take action against these actors.

**SUDAN - A COUNTRY BETWEEN DICTATORSHIP,  
REVOLUTION AND WAR.  
INFORMATION EVENT IN SUPPORT OF SUDANESE  
ANARCHISTS**

In Europe, Sudan is barely discussed in politics, the media and society. We want to change that. With a lecture and subsequent dialogue we will look at the historical, political and economic background to current events. We will also provide an insight into the work of the resistance movement against the military regime and paramilitary militia. The event is part of a solidarity campaign for Sudanese anarchists. Like countless other people, they have been forced to flee Sudan.

**'DON'T MOURN, ORGANIZE!'**

A conversation about the value of anarchist organization with people from Anarchist Group Amsterdam, Vrije Bond, Anarchist Bookfair & Paper Jam, Perspektieve Selbstverwaltung en de Camping ter Vrijheidsbeinning.

Anarchist organization is impactful on the personal, community and societal level. Why do people organize in long lasting anarchist groups? What does it bring you personally and why? How did it contribute to feelings of community and to long-term commitments

to activism? In this session we'll talk with participants of some of Dutch anarchism's most visible groups & then open up the conversation to exchange with the public.

**CARDS AND STORIES  
FOR AN ANTI-RACIST TOOLBOX**

This session exposes the workings of structural racism in our society and challenges participants to look at themselves. The first part confronts ignorance, in which racism thrives. Pieces of unknown and silenced history will be connected within an anti-colonial system analysis. Here, special attention will be paid to Indonesia and the former Dutch indies. During the second part, participants will be guided in conversation to reflect on themselves and their actions. We will do so with the help of a decolonial approach to the tarot, that is focused on collective healing and liberation.

**EDUCATION IN AN ANARCHIST MOVEMENT BY THE  
RADICAL SUNDAY SCHOOL**

What's wrong with the current educational system, according to anarchists? How can we create spaces where we can learn about the world and each other in ways that fight back against the problems in the status quo? How can anarchist free skools help us in our movement for a better world?

### **WALKINGWORKSHOP: HOW TO PL?**

Did you know that the first Pinkstermobilisatie by the Moker group took place 100 years ago? And that if you want to get together with your action group, you can do so at the campsite? This workshop is aimed at people who don't know many people yet or haven't been to the PL very often. We will take a walk around the campsite where different people will tell a bit about the history, present and future of the PL and the campsite.

### **ANTI-WAR RESISTANCE IN RUSSIA AND PRISONERS SUPPORT**

Arson attacks on military recruitment offices, sabotage on railroads, explosions at oil refineries and drone attacks on military bases have become a daily occurrence in Russia since Putin's army invaded Ukraine. At the same time, several hundred partisans have already ended up in Russian prisons. Traditional human rights organizations are not about to help the insurgents, so anti-authoritarian activists have taken up support for the arrested partisans.

### **INVOLVING MEN\* IN FEMINIST CHANGE IN ACTIVIST SPACES AND BEYOND**

With healthier masculinity & gender dynamics collectives mensEN, Emancipator and Patriarkaakt.

Toxic gender norms cause massive damage and it damages everyone, including people who internalize masculinity who disproportionately cause boundary crossing harm. The struggle for healthier gender dynamics has long been embodied by feminism, but men\* have often been conspicuously absent in this fight. These three collectives work to change this involvement and create healthier gender norms on the personal, community and societal level.

After some 20 minutes of presentation about their work & history, we'll split into groups to go more in depth to talk about the needs, challenges and successes in creating healthier gender dynamics and involving men\* in this process.



### **REFLECTING TOGETHER ON THE PALESTINE (STUDENT) ENCAMPMENTS OF MAY 2024**

A time to discuss the increased mobilization of the last weeks from our anarchists viewpoints. We will facilitate reflections on the modes of (non-) hierarchical organizing, the use of (non-)violence, the available resources, the police response, etc. that we have seen in Amsterdam and the rest of the Netherlands. This is a crucial time to gather people's potential for radical action, let's think about it together!

## CLIMBING

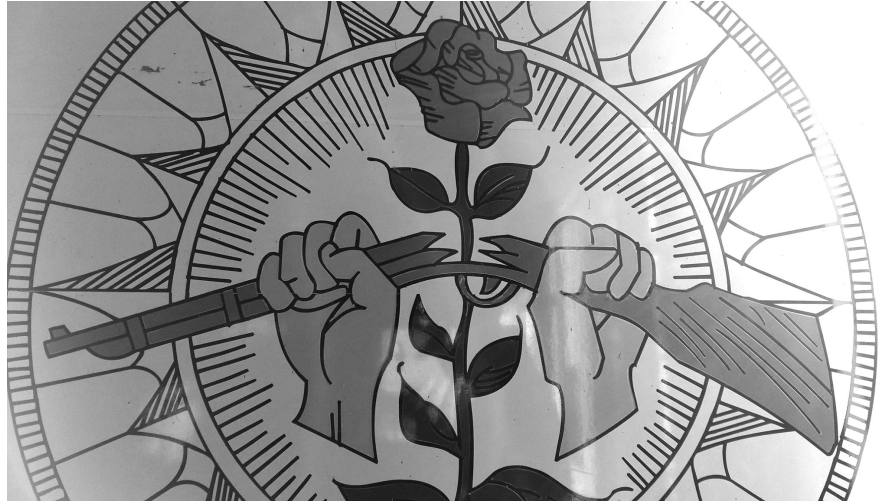
On Saturday will be climbing workshops. You can find out exactly when on the blackboard in front of the canteen. The climbers are more than happy to help you with making knots and with getting in and out of the tree safely.

The climbing training is given by people from C4C (climbers for climate). They want to have a special focus on FLINTA people. For this group there will be special trainings and ropes, only accessible to FLINTAs.

During the day there will also be open climbing trainings, but next to that there are also specific trainings (for FLINTA people or to learn how to hang a bed spiral or training for kids) and those trainings are bound to a set time. For the trainers it's nice if people are on time. The trainings can be in Dutch, English or German.

For an overview of specific trainings: check the schedule next to the big climbing tree and the schedule in the canteen! Also: you'll be needing some climbing skills for the game on Saturday night!
